Dear Year 5 families,

Year 6 Residential Visit to Boreatton Park 2022 **Monday 31st October – Friday 4th November 2022**

I am very happy to say that it is time for us to start thinking about our Year 6 residential trip to Boreatton Park in Year 6 (October 2022). Following the continued success of our residential visits to PGL Boreatton Park, we have managed to secure places for the end of 2022.

This trip is an action/adventure based visit and it is a fantastic part of Year 6. Throughout the trip, all children are supervised and trained to participate in a range of fun, exciting and challenging activities by the fully qualified and experienced PGL staff. In addition, a member of our school team will be with the children at all times. The emphasis of the trip is on teamwork and personal development.

We work hard to keep the costs of the trip to a minimum despite accommodation and transport costs rising each year. The cost of the 2022 trip will be £330.

If you would like to reserve a place for your child on this visit, please **make a deposit payment of £40.00 before Wednesday 1st December 2021, via ParentPay – in the same way as you do for Swimming / Dinners etc. Boreatton Park 2022 will be accessed via “other payment options”**. There is no consent form required at this point in time. You can make payments at your own leisure but all payments will be expected by 31st August 2022. Cancellations/refunds are dealt with on a case by case basis.

The cost of this trip will be reduced to half price for all pupils who qualify for Pupil Premium Funding. (Eligible for Free School Meals now, or at any point in the last 6 years.) For these children, you will see Boreatton Park 2022 - Ever 6 Children as your payment option. If you feel you are eligible but not registered for this yet, please contact the school office for assistance.

The cost includes all transport involved and full-board accommodation in comfortable dormitories with en-suite facilities. The children enjoy three hot meals each day and all supervision, instruction and safety gear, alongside the evening entertainment are included in the price.



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We have included an information leaflet about the Boreatton Park residential that may help to answer some of the more commonly asked questions. This is a general guide to the trip and some adjustments may have to be made to ensure the residential visit can be implemented safely.

Covid-19: It is important to note that although the DfE guidance is that residential visits are okay to proceed, circumstances may still arise which mean that the trip is not able to proceed – if this is the case, we will notify you as soon as possible and a full refund of all payments made will be provided.
